## ...with BASIC NEEDS

**Emergency Services** helps community members in crisis by offering food, hygiene items, information/referrals and financial payments for rent, utilities and some medical needs. Appointments are required for financial assistance; early arrivals are strongly encouraged for other requests.

We have two sites with varied services and hours—clients may access one or both locations:

**CENTRAL:** 3434 Branard St. (77027) Hours: Mon–Fri, 10AM-2PM; and Saturday, 9AM-Noon

**SOUTHWEST:** 6856 Bellaire Blvd. (77074) Hours: Mon/Tues/Thurs/Fri, 10AM-1PM; and Sat, 9AM-Noon

## ...with EMPLOYMENT

**JobNet** helps unemployed and underemployed persons find work. Participants can receive one-to-one coaching, computer classes, skill-building classes, resume advice, and access to computers and other office equipment (copier, fax, etc.) for job search. **Martha's Way** is a vocational training program offered in Spanish that helps participants learn how to run their own professional housekeeping businesses. We offer free classes in professional development, business skills, technical housekeeping skills, workplace safety, and an optional "ESL for Housekeeping" class.
