- Be between 14 years and older who have a substance use disorder.

The SUDOP Program allows Community Health Workers (CHWs) to provide outreach to assist those living with substance use disorders (SUD) in increasing their access and retention in substance use, mental health, and medical services. Services include Outreach, Assessment, and Case Management.
