

COUNSELING

FamilyTime offers comprehensive individual and family counseling. Counseling sessions provide a safe and confidential environment for survivors to express their feelings, thoughts, and fears. Counselors utilize nonjudgmental techniques as they listen and help survivors work through issues they may be experiencing. FamilyTime employs a trauma informed approach to aid clients in the healing process. Support groups are also offered for various subject matters.

CASE MANAGEMENT

FamilyTime provides case management services to survivors of domestic violence and sexual assault. Case managers organize and coordinate a network of formal and informal activities, services, and supports designed to optimize the well being of each client. Throughout the case management process, case managers act with consideration for the individual's cultural beliefs, interests, wishes, needs, and values. Case managers are responsible for helping clients and their support systems evaluate and understand their options, determine what is best to meet their needs, and institute action to achieve their goals and meet their interests and expectations.

HUMAN TRAFFICKING

Human trafficking is modern-day slavery. It is the exploitation of men, women and children for forced labor or sex by a third party for profit or gain.

Human trafficking involves the use of force, fraud, or coercion to obtain some type of labor or commercial sex act.

More than 300,000 victims of human trafficking in Texas, including almost 79,000 minors and youth victims of sex trafficking and nearly 234,000 adult victims of labor trafficking.

CHILD ABUSE

Child abuse, the mistreatment of a child that results in harm or injury.

There are four basic types of child abuse: neglect, physical, emotional, and sexual abuse.

Children being abused are likely to experience more than one type of abuse.

Today 175 Texas children will be victims of abuse.

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

Under Texas Law, family violence occurs when one member of a family acts towards another member of the household that is intended to result in physical harm or assault.

Family Violence, violence that occurs between family members, within households, or between dating partners. Threats of physical harm by one member household also meet the definition of family violence.

1 in 3 Texans will be a victim of domestic violence during their lifetime.

SHELTER

FamilyTime's shelter (The Door) is a place for temporary safe housing as well as the start of the healing process for survivors. The shelter can be an extremely powerful tool for empowering residents. The Door houses up to 38 survivors of family violence and sexual assault and their children in a safe and nurturing environment. The women and children receive meals and childcare, as well as counseling, guidance, and other needed services in preparation for transition to a more permanent and stable environment. The Door trains staff to provide day to day assistance, referrals for education, legal, vocational, housing, and additional social services.

SEXUAL ASSAULT

Sexual Assault, any action that pressures someone to do something sexually they don't want to do.

It can also refer to behavior that impacts a person's ability to control their sexual activity or the circumstances or restricting access to birth control or condoms.

1 in 3 women is a survivor of attempted or completed rape.

SEXUAL ASSAULT ACCOMPANIMENT

FamilyTime works with local hospitals to provide 24-hour victim/survivor accompaniment services to survivors of sexual assault. Advocates have been trained to provide comfort, education, information, and support survivors. Advocates are often on-site with the survivor during initial medical exams.
